
Chile was truly blessed to receive Mother Moon and five grandchildren on Monday, October 2, 2006. Their airplane landed at 10 am, and we quickly took them to the Ritz-Carlton Hotel, located in the capital's most prestigious neighborhood, El Golf. After officially greeting True Mother in the Presidential suite, the True Grandchildren were paired up with local people and taken to different locations for their events. There were so many details to take care of, as well as last minute changes, but everything worked out well, and each event was successful.



The high point, of course, was the main event with True Mother. It started off with a song by a well-known soprano singer, followed by the invocation given by Pastor Wilson Ruiz, president of the FFWPU in Chile. Next came a short speech by Rev. Thomas Field and the blessing ceremony conducted by him and his wife. Then came True Mother's speech, which was interrupted over and over by long and warm applause, often led by the grandchildren sitting in the front row.



Following the speech, two leading Peace Ambassadors presented Mother Moon with a beautiful, huge, one-of-a-kind, copper vase. As the Master of Ceremonies, Oscar Castro, led the audience in three cheers a deep feeling of joy and gratitude filled people's hearts. Afterwards, many peace ambassadors, women of the Women's Federation for World Peace, professors and others shared their reflections. One spoke of how she felt a magical spirit throughout the entire event; another, speaking with tears, said he realized that he needs to make a total change in his life and work with us to build a world of peace.


